Please go through the entrance of KYOTO TANGO RAILWAY at Fukuchiyama, Nishi-Maizuru, and Toyooka Stations. No refunds available for used Sea Area Passes. In the case of sudden transportation problems (e.g. bad weather), Sea Area Passes will not be available for sale.

Conditions of Purchase

- Passes can be purchased by:
 - Those who have a non-Japanese passport and a short-stay (tourist) visa;
 - Those who can display their return ticket to their own country and ED (embarkation/disembarkation) card;
 - Those who have a valid JR Pass and meet the above conditions;
 - Those who are deemed eligible to be sold the passes by the transportation operators.

Information on Purchase

- Passes can be purchased at the following KYOTO TANGO RAILWAY stations and on board: Fukuchiyama, Nishi-Maizuru, Miyazu, Amanohashidate and Toyooka Stations, and on Hashidate Express Trains between Fukuchiyama and Amanohashidate.
- Payments can be made in Japanese yen only. Credit cards (VISA, Master, JCB, American Express, Diners, Discover and China Union Pay card) are accepted at Miyazu and Amanohashidate Stations.

1 The house of the tycoon family Inaba (Kyotango City)

This is an old house of a wealthy merchant, a descendant of the Inaba clan from Mino area, who used to be a retainer of Nobunaga Oda. Botamochi, a Japanese rice dumpling covered with bean jam, is popular here.



2 Kyogamisaki Cape Lighthouse (Kyotango City)

This is one of one hundred scenic areas in Kyoto. This lighthouse is on a 140 meter high cliff at the tip of Tango Peninsula.

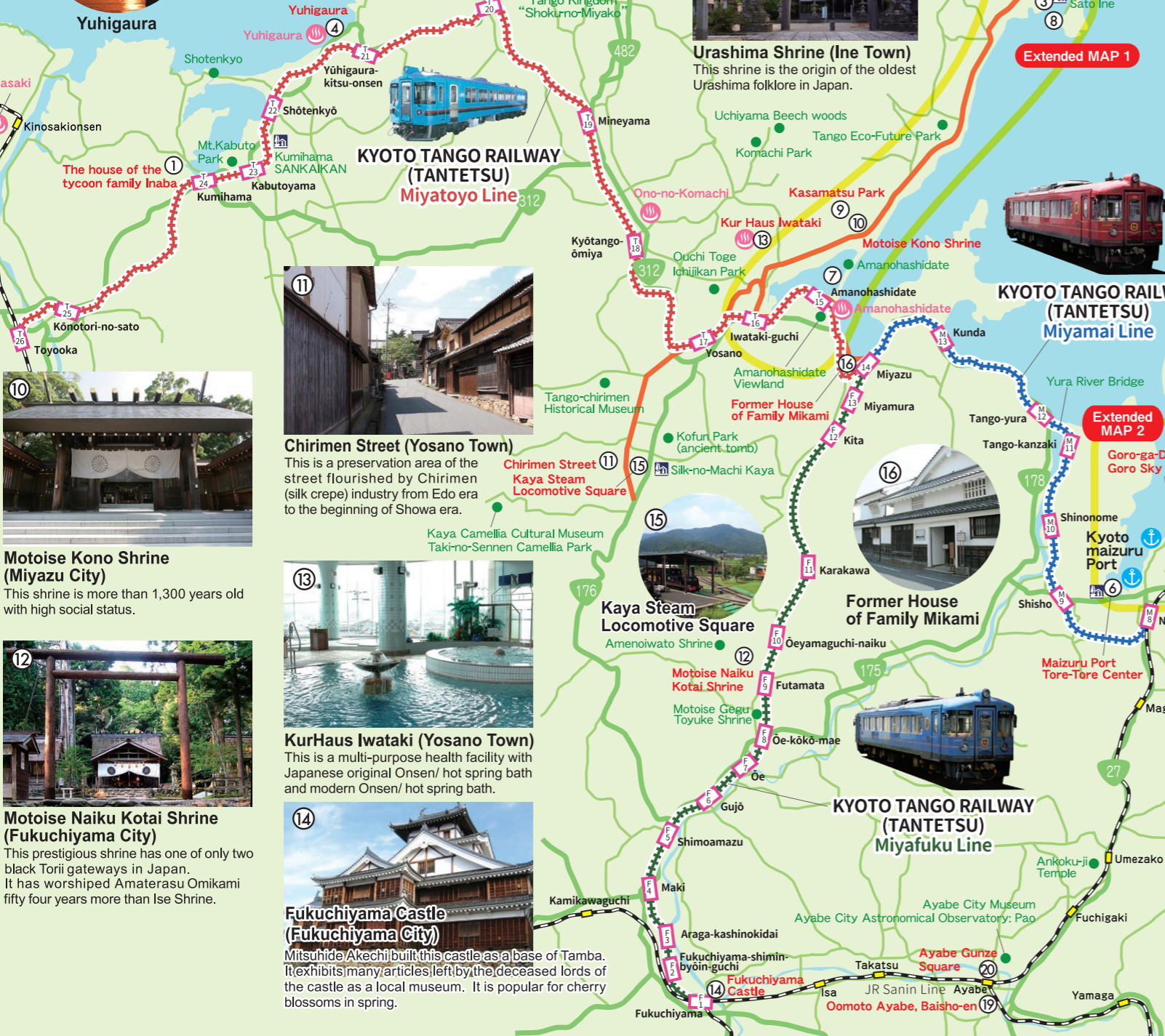


3 Ineura Funaya-gun, The boathouses of Bay (Ine Town)
The street is lined with funaya houses. Their first floor is the storage space and their boat workshop, and the second floor is their living space.

This is a sightseeing boat that cruises along Amanohashidate pine trees. You may feed seagulls.



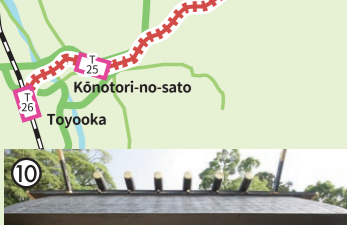
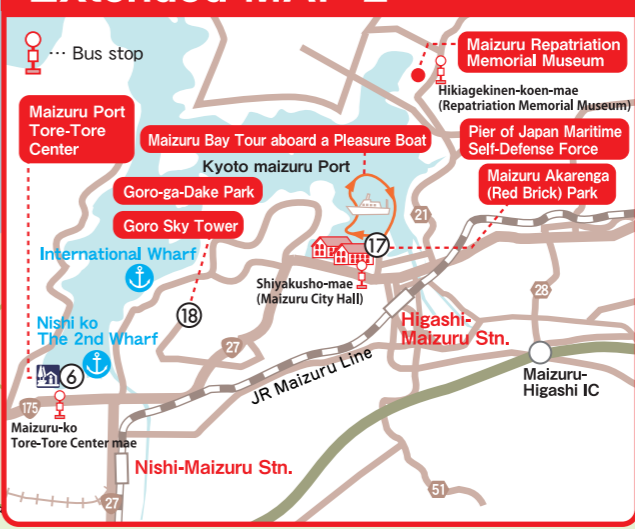
9 Kasamatsu Park (Miyazu City)

Extended MAP 1

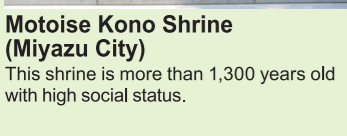

11 Chirimen Street (Yosano Town)

This is a preservation area of the street flourished by Chirimen (silk crepe) industry from Edo era to the beginning of Showa era.



12 Motoise Kono Shrine (Miyazu City)

This shrine is more than 1,300 years old with high social status.



13 Motoise Naiku Kotai Shrine (Fukuchiyama City)

This prestigious shrine has one of only two black Torii gateways in Japan. It has worshipped Amaterasu Omikami fifty four years more than Ise Shrine.



14 KurHaus Iwataki (Yosano Town)

This is a multi-purpose health facility with Japanese original Onsen/ hot spring bath and modern Onsen/ hot spring bath.



15 Fukuchiyama Castle (Fukuchiyama City)

Mitsuhide Akechi built this castle as a base of Tamba. It exhibits many articles left by the deceased lords of the castle as a local museum. It is popular for cherry blossoms in spring.



16 Former House of Family Mikami

This is a viewing location where you may enjoy the panorama of Amanohashidate, one of the top three most beautiful views of Japan.



17 Maizuru Akarenga (Red Brick) Park (Maizuru City)

A group of red brick warehouses are historical buildings. These are the most valuable modern heritage buildings among Japanese existing red brick buildings.



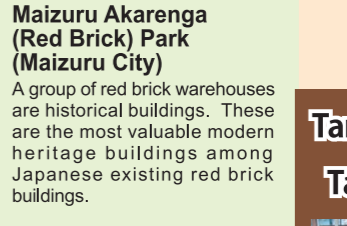
18 Goro-ga-Dake Park
